Crew Member Job Description

Thank you for your interest in our Federal Training Program with the Department of Labor, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, and Washington-Morgan Community Action. Because this is a federal training program you will not be able to collect unemployment at the end of your employment. Below is a description of the program and job responsibilities.

- The goals of the program are to help clean up public lands from the storm damage occurring February 14-28, 2018, and also to provide you with skills and a solid work history.
- You will be able to work up to 2080 hours or one year, whichever comes first. At the present time the grant is only approved until June 30, 2019. Based on the amount of unfinished work, the project could be extended.
- Work time will be from 8am-4:30pm, Monday-Friday. You will meet at a designated site and be transported to the work site as a group. One supervisor will be one assigned for each work crew.
- The work will be done along river and creek banks and will include cleaning out culverts, removing debris, cutting up fallen trees, repairing/clearing trails, and repairing/rebuilding things like picnic tables and foot bridges.
- The majority of work will be outside and will be performed in all weather conditions. Rain gear, winter weather wear, and boots will be provided.
- You must be able to walk more than two miles, in hilly terrain.
- You must be able to drag a 50-pound object 25 feet.
- You must be able to stand, stoop, and bend over for 15-30 minutes and work will involve repetitivemotion tasks.
- Safety equipment will be provided and must be used at any time you or another participant is running power equipment or hand tools.
- Training will be provided on the use of power tools, first aid/CPR, OSHA
